* As the recycling market begins to decline, shipping our recycled products into the marketable waste stream has begun to heavily impact the District. What was once revenue has now become an expense to dispose of. We are doing our best to bend with the market and ship when the price is right. As a result of this, it is imperative that we hold onto baled material longer than in previous years. To help with this we acquired two used storage trailers that afford us the flexibility to store materials until the price is "right"!

* The demand for landfill space in New Hampshire has increasingly put pressure on the disposal facilities to lock down tonnages and prices from its customers. After many years of independence and devastating rate increases for trash and demo disposal, the district has been given an opportunity to go under contract for the Municipal Solid Waste (trash) and Construction & Demolition disposal with Casella Waste Management with renewal options that could extend six years. This contract will stabilize the rate increases assessed by the Landfill Management.

- * As you are aware the "compost & brush" area has been discontinued at the facility. The mounds of un-processed yard waste will be part of a re-organization and approved management program by NHDES. You will begin to see some changes in the early summer months. Please give us a call to discuss alternative options.
